- 2 categories of entry**
- 1. Underwater images**
 - 2. On the water images**

You have until 5th October 2009 to submit your pictures of underwater and on the water subjects. First entry in either category is free, additional entries are £1 each (maximum of 6 entries in any one category). Entries can be made on the evening, but are preferred before.

Home or Away – Red Sea, North Sea, South Sea, Loch or Lake, Stoney, wrecks, seals, starfish, corals, whatever you wish.

2009 Photographic Competition – digital or non-digital images are accepted.

Winners announced 5th October 2009 and will be included in the minutes of the December Committee meeting
Closing dates for entries is 5th October 2009

There are 2 categories of entry:
Underwater photography, open to all members of SNBSAC.
Photography above or on the water, open to all. Members of SNBSAC

Entries preferred in hard copy format. Minimum size of picture 6in x 4in, maximum size A4. Photographs must not be digitally altered or enhanced unless these adjustments have been applied to the whole image. All photographs should be titled/captioned to include category, subject and location. Any technical information accompanying

entries is appreciated. All entries must be the competitor's own, but need not to have been taken in the year 2009. Digital only entries will be displayed on a laptop computer for judging.

The first entry for any category submitted by a competitor is free of charge. Additional entries for the same category must be accompanied by a payment of £1 per photograph to a maximum of 6 photographs including the free entry. Payment to be by cheque, payable to South Northants BSAC and must accompany multiple entries.

All entries need to be accompanied by details including competitors name, address.

SNBSAC will aim to return all entries within 2 weeks of results being announced providing a suitable stamped addressed envelope accompanies the entry, or can be returned on the evening following the competition. Entries may be submitted directly to any committee member of SNBSAC or by post to:
